Russell A. Barkley, Ph.D., is a clinical professor of psychiatry and pediatrics at the Medical University of South Carolina. He is a clinical scientist, educator, and practitioner who has published 21 books, rating scales, and clinical manuals numbering 28 editions. Dr. Barkley has appeared on nationally televised programs. He has received numerous awards for his career accomplishments, contributions to research in ADHD, to clinical practice, and for the dissemination of science.

- ▶ ADHD is a disorder in the development of self-regulation.
- ADHD is largely the result of neurological and genetic causes, although these interact with environmental factors, such as toxins, in producing the disorder.
- ADHD interferes with the development of the brain's executive functions, which give children the capacity to control their behavior.



- Understanding these executive abilities and how ADHD disrupts them can greatly assist parents in managing a child's behavior.
- This includes understanding how ADHD disrupts a child's sense of time and time management as well as their emotional self-control - beyond the effects the disorder has on working memory and impulse control.
- Besides using medication, parents can learn to modify the child's environment to improve the likelihood of better behavior.
